The novel *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* was published by Roald Dahl in 1964, followed by the film *Willy Wonka & the Chocolate Factory* in 1971. The production you are watching today is a musical stage adaptation of the book combined with the film.

Willy Wonka Jr. is set relatively close to the present day. I won't tell you exactly when or where our show is set. I believe that part of the fun is you getting to subconsciously make those decisions.

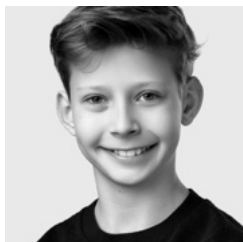

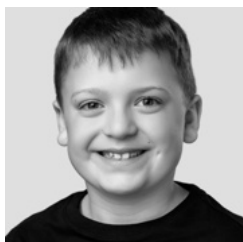

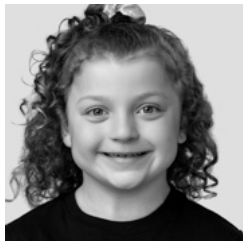

as Mr. Bucket

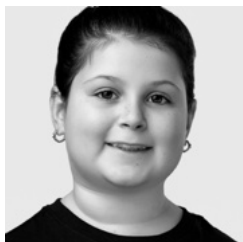
